Our vision is a Central Texas community where generosity flourishes - empowering nonprofits and individuals to create lasting, positive change through philanthropy.

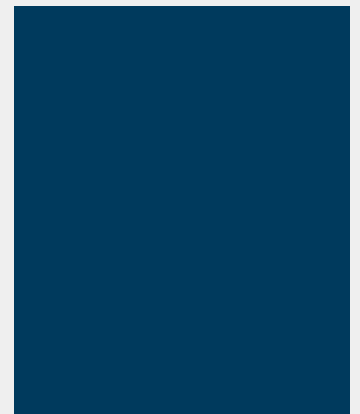
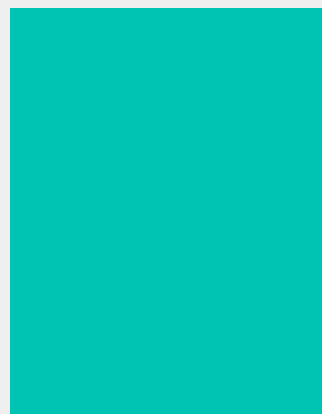

ORGANIZATIONAL GROWTH

In 2025, Central Texas Community Foundation continued to strengthen its internal capacity and expand its impact across the region.

Amy Mizcles joined the Foundation as Program Officer for Rural Community Investments, leading the development and implementation of the Rural Impact Investment Fund (RIIF). Through this work, CTXCF deepened its commitment to community-informed, participatory grantmaking, engaging residents across Bastrop, Caldwell, Hays, and Williamson counties to shape funding priorities and decisions.

The Foundation also continued to build momentum behind The Center for Nonprofit Success, a collaborative initiative designed to support nonprofit organizations across our 30-county region. Grounded in extensive input from nonprofit leaders, The Center reflects CTXCF's commitment to strengthening the nonprofit sector through accessible resources, strategic guidance, and long-term capacity building.

Internally, the Foundation refined roles and operations to better support growing programs and donor engagement, ensuring a strong infrastructure to meet the evolving needs of the Central Texas community.

OUR SERVICES

At CTXCF, we provide a range of philanthropic services designed to support individuals, families, businesses, and nonprofits in making a lasting impact in Central Texas.

Donor Advised Funds (DAFs): Tailored philanthropic solutions that allow donors to strategically manage and leverage their giving.

Endowments, Field of Interest, Designated, Scholarship, & Pass-Through Funds: Customized philanthropic tools to support charitable goals, working closely with donors to find the perfect giving solution.

Agency Funds & Agency Endowments: Helping nonprofits grow their assets through pooled investments and expert asset management for long-term sustainability.

Nonprofit Capacity Building: Consultative support, funding opportunities, and increased awareness, through programs like Philanthropy Hour and our Giving Circles.

Intermediary Funding: Strengthening the nonprofit ecosystem in Bastrop, Hays, Caldwell, and East Williamson Counties to improve community health and well-being.

Fiscal Sponsorships: Offering financial management, administrative support, and tax-exempt status to nonprofit projects in need of structure and resources.

Disaster Relief: Managing funds in response to local disasters and national crises, with over \$10 million distributed to individuals in times of need.

Through these services, the community is empowered to create meaningful change and ensure a brighter future for Central Texas.

More than a decade later, that initial experience has grown into long-term involvement. Today, Shayne serves on the Foundation’s Board of Directors, continuing to support and inspire others to engage in meaningful giving.

RESPONDING WHEN IT MATTERS MOST

In July 2025, Central Texas experienced catastrophic flooding that devastated communities across the region, leaving families facing significant loss and uncertainty.

In response, the Central Texas Community Foundation mobilized quickly, partnering with Travis County CARES and WilCo CARES to deliver direct financial support to those most impacted. Through an extraordinary outpouring of generosity from donors, community partners, and regional leaders, more than \$8 million was raised to support recovery efforts.

The first round of funding was distributed in November 2025, with \$3.35 million granted to 115 families across Travis and Williamson counties. These grants—ranging from \$500 to \$100,000—provided immediate relief for critical needs such as housing repairs, transportation, and basic necessities as families began the long process of rebuilding. A second round of funding is scheduled for distribution in May 2026, continuing this support as recovery efforts progress.

This response demonstrated the strength of a connected community—one that shows up with urgency, compassion, and purpose when it matters most. By combining resources, coordinating across partners, and ensuring funds were distributed thoughtfully and equitably, the Foundation helped deliver meaningful support to those facing some of their most difficult moments.

The Foundation remains committed to stewarding these funds responsibly and supporting recovery efforts as they move forward, ensuring resources reach those most impacted with care and intention.

CONTINUED GROWTH THROUGH THE YEARS

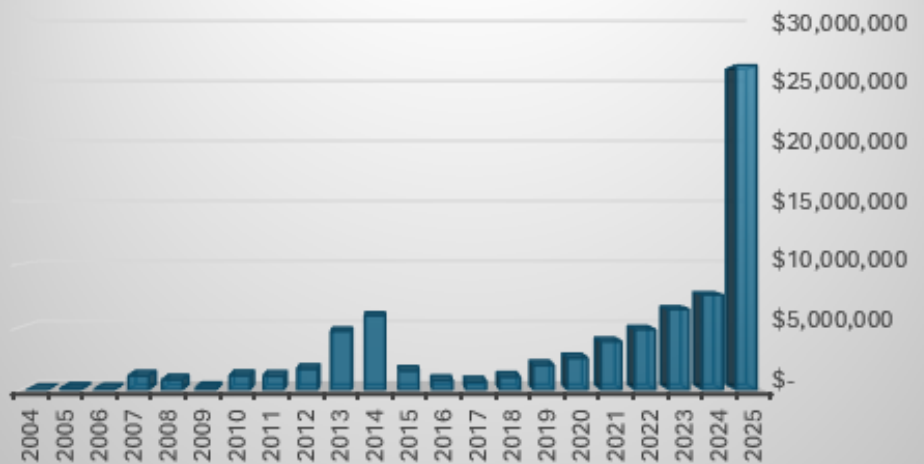
Over the past year, our Foundation has experienced remarkable growth, a testament to the generosity and commitment of our donors and partners. Assets under management now exceed \$40 million. This financial growth translates directly into more lives changed, as grants distributed also increased, doubling the grant distributions from \$4.5 million in 2024 to over \$10 million in 2025, with an additional \$4.2 million in disaster relief payments. With each dollar distributed, we are strengthening nonprofits, addressing critical community needs, and empowering those who serve Central Texas.

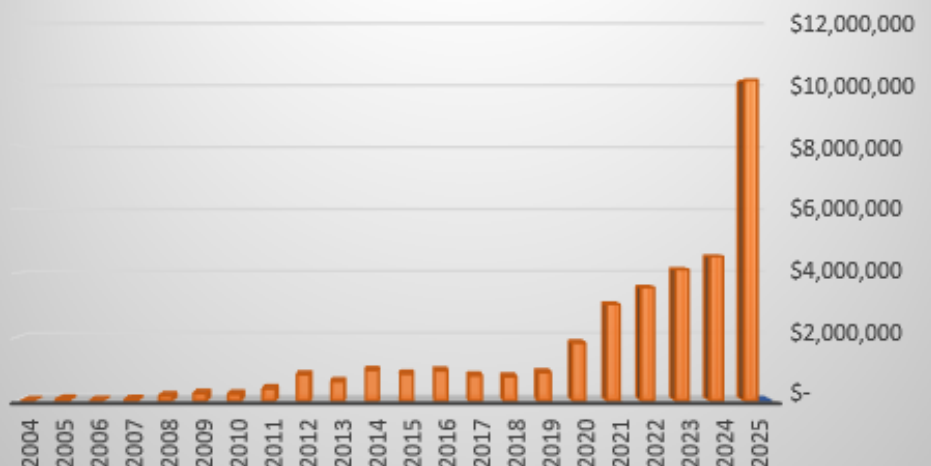

Annual Total Contributions



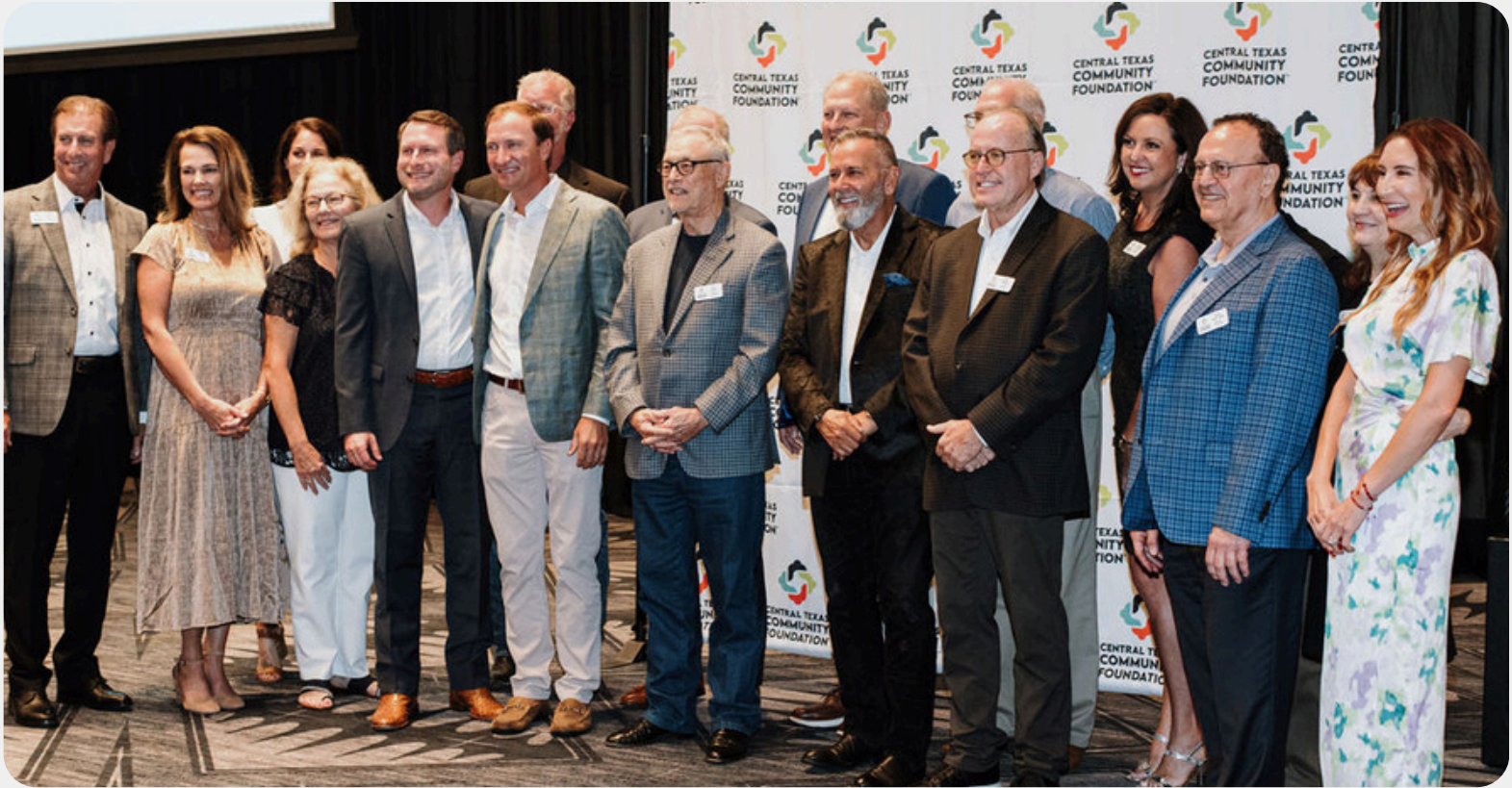
Annual Grants
